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

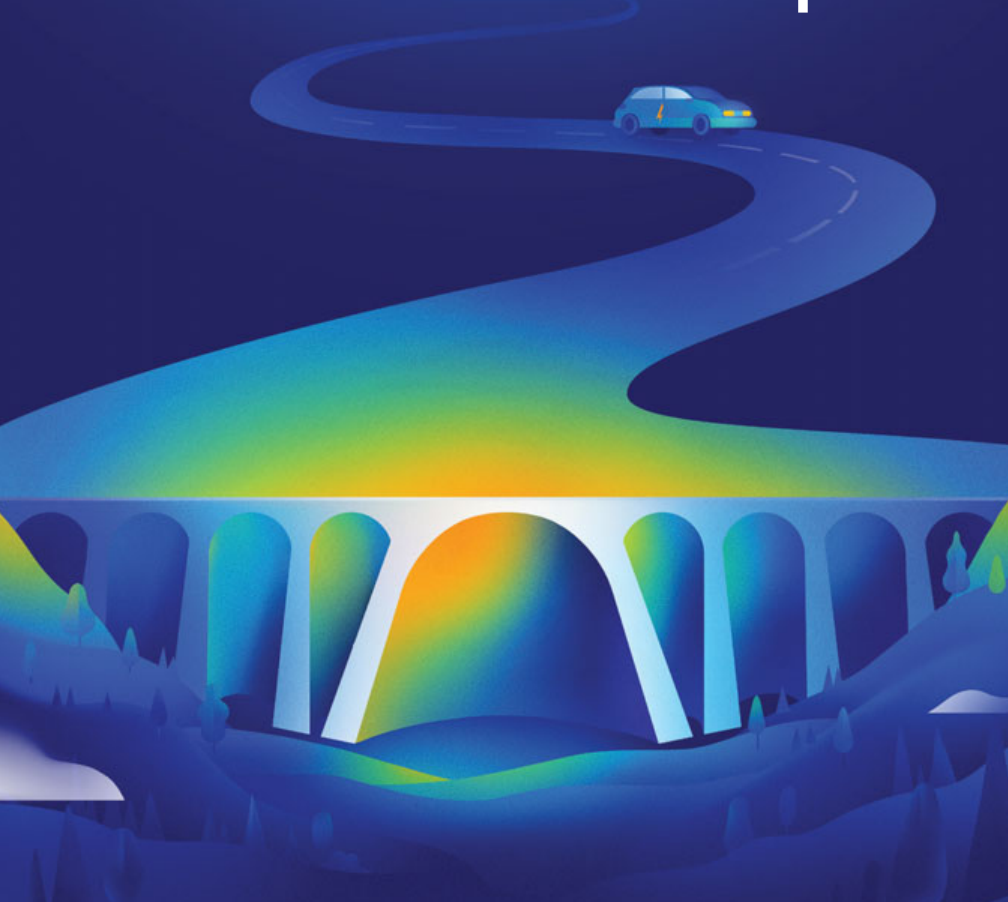

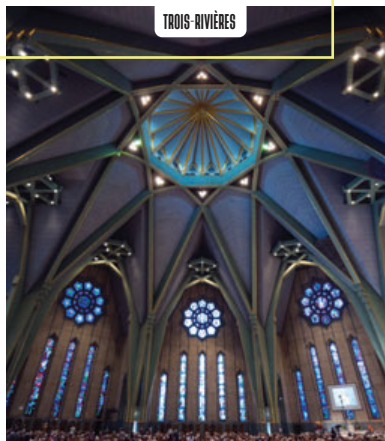
MONT SM

7 DOWNTOWN TROIS-RIVIÈRES

Every summer, downtown Trois-Rivières comes alive with festivals, cultural events, and nightlife. 8 SAINT-AURICE RIVER

Once a key waterway for First Nations and fur traders, the Saint-Maurice River became famous for its log driving era. Today, it offers aquatic adventures between La Tuque and Trois-Rivières, where boaters have replaced log drivers, enjoying the beauty and recreational activities of the river!



9 COGECO AMPHITHEATRE

Located at the confluence of the Saint-Maurice River and Saint Lawrence River, the outdoor stage of the Cogeco Amphitheatre hosts large-scale performances every summer. Among the must-see events are the spectacular Cirque du Soleil shows, running until 2025. In winter, the venue transforms into the Cabaret, a cozy indoor theater.

10 CITÉ DE L'ÉNERGIE

An internationally renowned tourist destination and a landmark of the Shawinigan landscape, La Cité de l'Énergie features a 115-metre observation tower, a Canadian multimedia show, and the *Planète Énergie* exhibition, which offers 20 interactive stations. Visitors can also enjoy the Jean Chrétien Prime Minister's Museum, which highlights Canada's influence in the world.

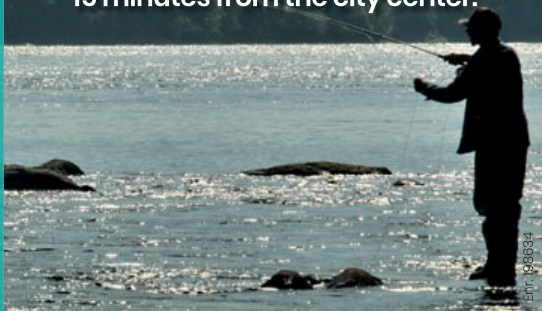

Beautiful tricentennial city

As the second oldest French-speaking city in North America, Trois-Rivières allows its visitors to immerse themselves in the daily lives of the first settlers during a stroll through its charming historic district, a postcard that gradually reveals itself to the visitor who takes the time to soak it in. Exploring it on foot is definitely the best way to appreciate all its beauties. Here, the past and present coexist as art galleries and artistic residences have opened up public access to architectural gems from the colonial era.

A few steps away, the daily lives of workers in the 19th and 20th-century forestry industry are highlighted in interactive exhibitions and spectacular installations at Boréal's paper industry museum. Be sure not to miss the iconic Cogeco Amphitheatre, crowned with gigantic wooden letters spelling "Trois-Rivières." Its characteristic architecture has earned it a prestigious award. As a bonus, the site offers beautiful bike and pedestrian paths providing access to stunning viewpoints of the Saint-Maurice and Saint Lawrence Rivers.

Once an important trading post during the time of Louis XIV and even earlier, Trois-Rivières is also the birthplace of industry in New France. In 1736, the Forges du Saint-Maurice were established north of the city, now a national historic site of Parks Canada. This significant part of Quebec's economic history has been preserved over the years and is now told in a fascinating experiential tour.

The historic center and urban life to the south, industrial history to the north—yet the tricentennial beauty has much more to offer to visitors who are willing to give it a little more time. Lake Saint-Pierre, declared a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, the Our Lady of the Cape Shrine, where hundreds of thousands of pilgrims gather annually, Île Saint-Quentin, where locals love to cool off on sunny days—these are just a few examples of exceptional sites worthy of interest throughout the city.

City of culture and celebration

Recognized for its artistic vitality, the former Cultural Capital of Canada continues to inspire and captivate with its numerous festivals, internationally acclaimed events, exhibitions, and performances presented throughout the city. Don't be surprised if, around a street corner, you encounter some dance moves, the beat of a musical performance, poetry recitation, or an invitation to participate in street art performances. Truly, all senses are engaged by musicians, actors, dancers, visual artists, and other fascinating creators who share their passion.

Since 2015, Cirque du Soleil has made Trois-Rivières its summer home, offering dynamic performances that celebrate Quebec culture.

And the best way to enjoy the city's museums? The Museum Card, which provides access to around fifteen attractions, including the Musée POP, the Old Prison, and the tourist bus.

All of this, right at your fingertips!

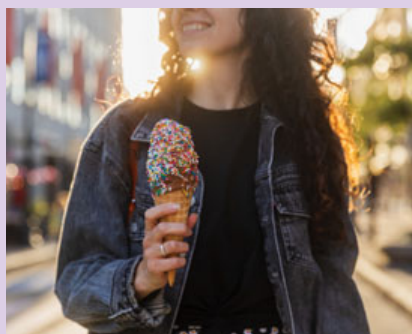
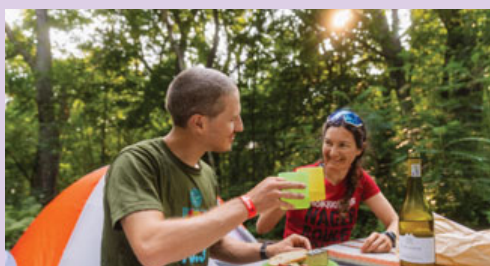


The paradise for epicureans

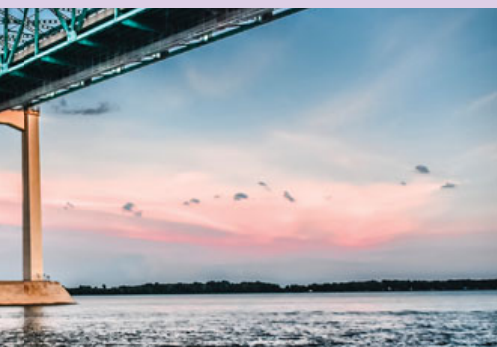


A newly revamped Tourist Information Office

Our slogan, So Close, represents our pluralistic perspective: our closeness to people and our territory.

Located about 30 minutes from Trois-Rivières and less than an hour from Québec City, the MRC of des Chenaux is an unexplored gem. But if you take the time to travel our roads, you will discover the treasures hidden in our 10 municipalities.

Let yourself be carried away by the richness of our heritage buildings by browsing the Sacré circuit visiting route. Listen to a podcast about the circuit, *La voix des bâtisseurs* (in French only), visit a maple sugar shack during sugaring off season or go meet our producers, market gardeners and restaurateurs throughout the area.





The MRC des Chenaux is a lesser-known territory crossed by two rivers that have a reputation for being unpredictable. The Sainte-Anne River is calm in summer and shines in winter with the lights from the ice fishing cabins. In the Parc de la rivière Batiscan, the river shimmers, with waterfalls that can be tranquil, and other times flow abundantly.



So Active!

There are great activities to do in the MRC de des Chenaux in every season. Pluck up your courage and surpass yourself by climbing the Via ferrata at the **Parc de la rivière Bastiscan**. Don't forget to cross the river on the zipline at the end. Walk in the trails, admire the waterfalls and let the roar of tumbling water accompany your journey. At the **Domaine Enchanteur**, big thrills await you in the suspended labyrinth, an aerial course of 70 modules. In winter, you can cross 15 km of ice-covered trails through the animal parks in the domain. In the MRC de des Chenaux, you can also take a horse-drawn carriage ride in the forest, wrapped in a warm blanket, and why not go tease the tomcod on the Sainte-Anne River while you are cozy and warm in a small fishing cabin, there are so many activities to choose from.

So Gourmet!

Come savour the delicious products available in our region. During the summer, it is so much fun to go fruit picking in the fields. Our producers offer you a great variety of fruits: strawberries, raspberries, blueberries, apples and even pumpkins in the autumn. On your way, make a gourmet stop at the local businesses in the MRC: microbreweries, a cheese maker, bakeries, vineyards, market gardeners, breeders, gourmet food shops and stands with local products are waiting to welcome you.

A great base camp for your outdoors adventures, come get your dose of nature at La Mauricie National Park! Summer trippers: you are going to love the hiking, canoeing and waterfalls. If snow is your thing: marked trails and heated cabins are great for snowshoeing and cross-country skiing.

TRAVELLING IN QUÉBEC

Bars, casinos and purchasing alcohol

You must be at least 18 years old to enter bars, pubs, nightclubs and casinos, as well as to purchase or consume alcohol (be prepared to produce ID if asked). Wines and spirits are sold through the Société des alcools du Québec (SAQ), the provincial liquor board. Beer is available at grocery and convenience stores, which also stock a limited selection of wines.

Currency exchange

There are numerous exchange offices in Québec's main urban centres. Airports also offer exchange services. Some businesses accept American money, but tend to offer a less competitive rate than the exchange offices.

Driving in Québec

Since Canada uses the metric system, speed limits and distances are posted in kilometres per hour (km/h) and gasoline is sold by the litre (l).

Cell phones

Use of a cell phone is prohibited while driving.

Drugs and driving

This Act introduces a zero-tolerance principle when it comes to drugs and driving by prohibiting anyone from driving a vehicle if there is a detectable presence of cannabis or any other drug in that person's saliva. Offenders are subject to an immediate 90-day suspension of their driver's licence.

According to the law, you must be at least 21 years old to purchase or consume cannabis (be prepared to produce ID if asked). The legislation also includes other measures, such as the prohibition from consuming drugs (cannabis or any other drug) in a road vehicle, on an off-road vehicle or on a bicycle.

Winter tires

From December 1st to March 15, all taxis and passenger vehicles registered in Québec must be equipped with winter tires. This requirement also applies to rental passenger vehicles in Québec.

Tourist routes

The official tourist routes are clearly marked with blue signs. They are designed to highlight the attractions of the regions through which they pass, and to enable visitors to discover the extent of Québec's natural and cultural treasures. bonjourquebec.com/en-ca/where-to-go/routes-and-itineraries.

Tourist signage

In Québec, tourist regions and directions to services, attractions and activities are indicated by blue road signs. For more information, visit panneaubleu.com and tourisme.gouv.qc.ca/signalisation (in French only).

Village-relais accredited services

If you feel like taking a break or require assistance while on the road, look for the Village-relais signs. These point to villages that, together with local businesses, offer a range of accredited services and a safe and pleasant place to stop. villages-relais.qc.ca.

Voltage

In Québec, the standard voltage is 110 volts/60 cycles, as it is throughout North America. Since the outlets cannot accommodate European plugs, you will need to bring or buy an adaptor.

Canadian currency

The legal currency in Québec is the Canadian dollar (CAD), which is divided into 100 cents. Bank notes are available in denominations of 5, 10, 20, 50 and 100 dollars, and coins in denominations of 5, 10 and 25 cents as well as 1 and 2 dollars. Bank cards and major credit cards are also accepted almost everywhere.

Tipping

Tipping is customary in restaurants, bars and taxis. The amount, which is not included in the bill, is generally equivalent to 15% of the total bill before taxes. For quick tip calculations, Québécois normally add up both taxes. Tipping bellhops or porters is at your discretion (generally, \$1 per bag).

Taxes

Québec has two taxes: the 5% federal goods and services tax (GST), and the 9.975% Québec sales tax (QST). An accommodation tax of 3.5% of the room price per night also applies in our region.

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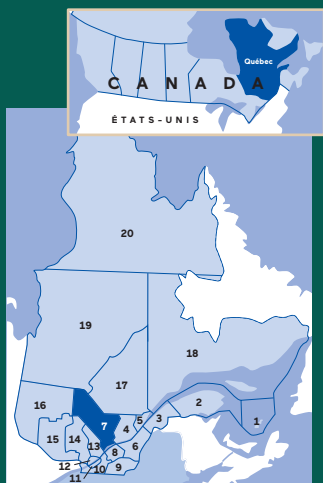
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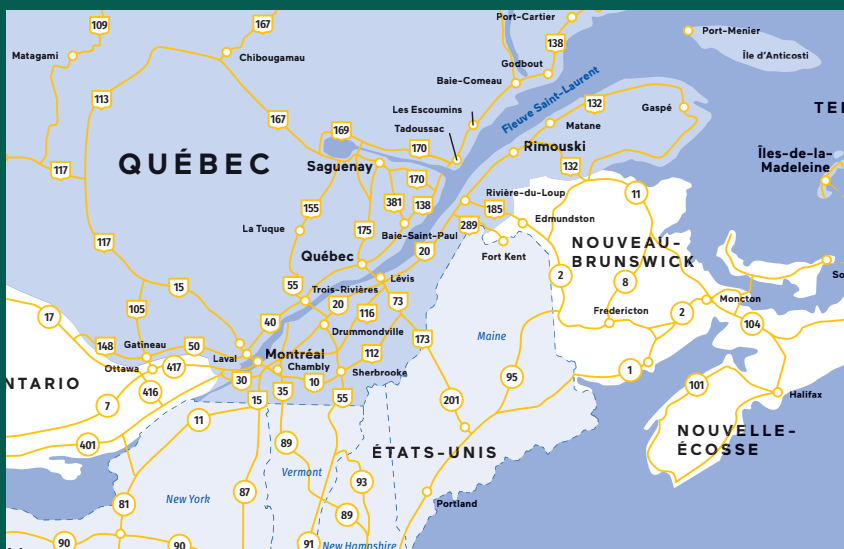
